Conditions of use of photograph/film consent

We will not include details of full names (ie first name and surname) of any child in an image or video, on our website, or in printed publications without good reason. For example, we may include the full name of a competition prize winner if we have consent. If we use images in a group they will only be identified with a general label eg: "Class 1 at Holt Hall".

We will not include personal email or postal addresses, or telephone or fax numbers on video, our website or printed publications.

We will only use images of young people who are suitably dressed to reduce the risk of such images being used inappropriately.

We cannot film or take photographs of any child that is at risk or under a supervision order.

Where permission to use images is not given, the school will be as tactful as possible in excluding children from group photographs, but it would be helpful if parents could explain to their child that this will happen.
